THE POWER OF PRAYERFUL ACTION

Scripture calls believers to pray for those in authority so that our communities may experience peace, order, and godliness. Prayer is not a substitute for engagement. It is the foundation that prepares us to engage wisely, humbly, and faithfully.

A SACRED RESPONSIBILITY

As followers of Christ and citizens of the United States, we are called to a high standard of participation in our governing process. Voting is more than a civic privilege. It is an opportunity to steward our God-given influence and help shape the future of our communities and nation.

While midterm elections may not receive the same attention as a presidential election, their impact is significant. From Congress to local offices, the leaders elected in 2026 will help guide policies that affect families, churches, communities, and future generations.

First of all, then, I urge that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgivings be made for all people, for kings and all who are in high positions, that we may lead a peaceful and quiet life, godly and dignified in every way. 1 Timothy 2:1-2

IDENTITY IN CHRIST

- Listen with Grace: Be quick to listen and slow to speak, remembering God's sovereignty above every circumstance.
- Stand Firm in Truth: Hold to your convictions while speaking with gentleness and respect.

YOUR 2026 MIDTERM ACTION PLAN

Faithful citizenship begins before Election Day. As believers, we are called to seek God's wisdom, prepare diligently, and approach the voting process with prayerful discernment.

PRAY FIRST

Before making any decision, ask the Lord for insight. Pray that He would align your heart with His truth and help you evaluate issues and candidates with wisdom and conviction.

PREPARE FAITHFULLY

Look beyond headlines, advertisements, and commentary. Research the candidates and issues that will appear on your ballot, review important election deadlines, and ensure your voter registration is up to date. As you prepare, ask God for wisdom to discern the principles and priorities that matter most.

- **Candidates:** Pray that candidates at every level would have godly influences, leading them to seek wisdom, act with integrity, and receive biblical truth.
- **Election Integrity:** Pray for honesty, transparency, and fairness among voters, volunteers, election workers, and officials.
- **National Unity:** Pray that God would draw hearts across America to Him, fostering respectful dialogue and reconciliation in our nation.
- **The Electorate:** Pray that Christians would evaluate candidates and issues through a biblical lens, seeking God's guidance with confidence and peace.

PRESSURE ON CHURCH LEADERS

Our Prayer for Pastors and Congregations:

- **Boldness and Wisdom:** Pray that pastors will confidently lead their congregations to evaluate our world through a biblical lens, standing firmly on the truth of Scripture.
- **Spiritual Focus:** Pray that church leaders remain anchored in the gospel, remembering that the focus must always be on praying, not on politics.
- **Unity:** Pray that our churches would be safe sanctuaries of grace, where believers can gather together in prayer and care for the interests of one another and avoid hostile debates.
